

ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON AMENDING UNIVERSITY PLACE MUNICIPAL CODE (UPMC) SECTION 2.25.030, MEMBERSHIP, TO PROVIDE THAT APPOINTEES TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION WILL IMMEDIATELY FORFEIT THEIR APPOINTMENT UPON LOSING THEIR RESIDENCY STATUS BY MOVING OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS.


Section 1. Section 2.25.030, Membership, of the University Place Municipal Code, is amended as follows:

2.25.030 Membership

The planning commission shall be comprised of seven members. Members shall be city residents, except the City Council may appoint up to one member who may reside outside the City. ~~one member may reside outside the city.~~ For purposes of this section, persons shall be considered residents if they live in the City of University Place. Appointees to the planning commission will immediately forfeit their appointment when they lose their residency status by moving outside the city limits. The planning commission shall be appointed by the city council and be advisory to the council. Members of the planning commission shall serve without compensation. No more than two members shall be engaged in the same kind of occupation, business, trade or profession. In addition, it is desirable, but not mandatory, that the planning commission members be drawn from throughout the city.

Section 2. Publication and Effective Date. A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official Newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect five days after publication.


