

ORDINANCE NO. 284

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 9.10.030 PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY PLACE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY ELIMINATING THE WORDS "AUTOMATIC POLICE" FROM SECTION A

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted Chapter 9.10.030 Permit Requirements to the UPMC regarding permits for alarm systems; and

WHEREAS, Section A of Chapter 9.10.030 included the wording "automatic police alarm system," which created confusion as to the type of alarm systems covered under this section; and

WHEREAS, it is easier to understand the intent of Section A if the words "automatic police" are omitted from the section; NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amending Section A of Chapter 9.10.030 of the University Place Municipal Code. Section A of Chapter 9.10.030 of the University Place Code hereby is amended to read as follows:

9.10.030 Permit Requirements

A. Permit Required. No person shall operate or use an alarm system on any premises within the City of University Place under that person's control without first having obtained from the Department a separate permit for each premise protected by an alarm system. The Department need not respond to any alarm system for which a permit has not first been obtained. For the purposes of this Section, a person shall be deemed to be an operator or user of an alarm system if:

1. The person controls both the alarm system and the premises upon which it is installed; or
2. The person controls the premises and is the subscriber, client, or tenant of the system subscriber; or
3. The person is the system subscriber.

Section 2. Effective Date and Publication. A summary of this Ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This Ordinance shall be in effect at 12:01 a.m. on the fifth day after publication.


