

ORDINANCE NO. 260

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, REPEALING CHAPTER 5.05, APPLICATION AND ISSUANCE OF BUSINESS LICENSES, OF THE UNIVERSITY PLACE MUNICIPAL CODE.

Whereas, on September 23, 1996, the City Council of the City of University Place passed Ordinance No. 119, establishing a general business registration/licensing requirement for any person engaged in any business activity in the City of University Place, unless specifically exempted.

Whereas, on May 19, 1997, the City Council of the City of University Place passed ordinance No. 144, amending the business licensing requirements to add special provisions for peddlers and solicitors;

Whereas, the general business registration/licensing requirements and those pertaining to peddlers and solicitors were subsequently codified in Chapter 5.05 of the University Place Municipal Code;

Whereas, due to financial considerations mandating a reduction in service and staffing levels in the City's administration, the City Council determined the need to eliminate the city's general business registration/licensing requirements and to repeal Chapter 5.05, Application and Issuance, of Title 5, Business Licenses and Regulations, of the University Place Municipal Code;
NOW, THEREFORE,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal of Chapter 5.05, Application and Issuance, of Title 5, Business Licenses and Regulations, of the University Place Municipal Code.

Chapter 5.05, Application and Issuance, of Title 5 of the University Place Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Publication and Effective Date. A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the city. This ordinance shall be effective on January 1, 2000.
