ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1999-2000 SALARY PLAN ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 211 ADOPTING THE 1999-2000 BIENNIAL BUDGET BY ADJUSTING THE ASSISTANT FINANCE DIRECTOR SALARY RANGE AND ESTABLISHING THE RECREATION MANAGER AND PARKS PROJECTS MANAGER SALARY RANGES

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1998, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 211 adopting the 1999-2000 Biennial Budget, Salary Schedule, and Benefits Plan, Authorizing Positions, and Appropriating Funds;

WHEREAS, on January 28, 1999, the City Council established the Assistant Finance Director position in Ordinance No. 224 adopted February 8, 1999;

WHEREAS, with the departure of the Parks & Recreation Manager, it is necessary to reallocate the responsibilities to respond to the work plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>1999-2000 Salary Plan Amended.</u> The 1999-2000 Salary Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 211 with the 1999-2000 biennial budget, is hereby amended to adjust the Assistant Finance Director salary range to match the existing Information Services Manager salary range. The Recreation Manager and Parks Projects Manager salary ranges are also established:
