A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE,  
WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING THE OFFICIAL CITY  
REPRESENTATIVE TO THE PIERCE COUNTY  
CONSERVATION FUTURES ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, The Pierce County Conservation Futures program was established by the Pierce County Council in 1991;

WHEREAS, the Pierce County Conservation Futures Program allows for the purchase of open space property by Pierce County. Pierce County may convey the Deed to the open space property to a Non-profit Land Trust, City, Town or Park District and require certain performances from those groups.


WHEREAS, being a City with a population of over 10,000, the City of University Place is entitled to nominate an Official City Representative.
