

RESOLUTION NO. 182

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING AN OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER, AND AN ALTERNATE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 10.

WHEREAS, on May 31, 1995, the City of University Place adopted Resolution No. 10, designating the Tacoma News Tribune as its "official newspaper," pursuant to RCW 35A.21.230.

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the City of University Place to designate the University Place Journal as its "official newspaper" in order to save taxpayer money and city staff time relating to legal publications of the City;

WHEREAS, the University Place Journal meets the criteria set forth by State statute that it is a newspaper of general circulation and interest, and has been published at least once a week in the City of University Place for a period in excess of the preceding six months, and is compiled either in whole or in part in an office maintained at the place of publication;

WHEREAS, the News Tribune of Tacoma will be designated the "alternate official newspaper" for legal publications when necessary in order to meet required or desired timelines; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Designate Official City Newspaper. The City of University Place, Washington, designates the University Place Journal as its official newspaper.

Section 2. Designate Alternate Official City Newspaper. The City of University Place, Washington, designates the Tacoma News Tribune as its alternate official newspaper;

Section 3. Repealer. Resolution No. 10, Designating an Official Newspaper, is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
