

RESOLUTION NO. 242

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING MECHANICAL CODE FEES AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED
UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 155**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance, the City has authorized fees and charges for services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 155 amended Mechanical Code fees, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to recover the cost of services where fees are appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF UNIVERSITY PLACE AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Mechanical Code Fees Amended. Mechanical Code Fees are hereby amended as set forth on Schedule A, Mechanical Code Fees, attached hereto and made part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect on immediately upon adoption, with fees effective December 31, 1999.

MECHANICAL CODE FEES

Permit Issuance

1. For the issuance of each permit	\$22.00	\$23.50
2. For issuing each supplemental permit for which the original permit has not expired, been canceled or finalized.	\$6.50	\$7.25

Unit Fee Schedule

1. Furnaces. For the installation or relocation of each forced air or gravity-type furnace or burner, including ducts and vents attached to such appliance, up to and including 100,000 Btu/h (29.3 kW).	\$13.25	\$14.80
For the installation or relocation of each forced air or gravity-type furnace or burner, including ducts and vents attached to such an appliance over 100,000 Btu/h (29.3 kW)	\$16.25	\$18.20
For the installation or relocation of each floor furnace, including vent	\$13.25	\$14.80
For the installation or relocation of each suspended heater, recessed wall heater or floor mounted unit heater	\$13.25	\$14.80
2. Appliance Vents. For the installation, relocation, or replacement of each appliance vent installed and not included in an appliance permit	\$6.50	\$7.25
3. Repairs and Additions. For the repair of, alteration of, or addition to each heating appliance, refrigeration unit, cooling unit, absorption unit, or each heating, cooling, absorption or evaporation cooling system, including installation of controls regulated by the Mechanical Code	\$12.25	\$13.70
4. Boilers, Compressors, and Absorption Systems. For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor to and including three horsepower (10.6 kW) or for each absorption system to and including 100,000 Btu/h (29.4 kW)	\$13.15	\$14.70
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over three horsepower (10.6 kW) to and including 15 horsepower (52.7 kW) or for each absorption system over 100,000 Btu/h (29.3 kW) to and including 500,000 Btu/h (146.6 kW)	\$24.25	\$27.15
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 15 horsepower (52.7 kW) to and including 30 horsepower (105.5 kW), or for each absorption system over 500,000 Btu/h (146.6 kW) to and including 1,000,000 Btu/h (293.1 kW)	\$33.25	\$37.25
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 30 horsepower (105.5 kW) to and including 50 horsepower (176 kW), or for each absorption system over 1,000,000 Btu/h (293.1 kW) to and including 1,750,000 Btu/h (512.9 kW)	\$49.50	\$55.45
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 50 horsepower (176 kW), or for each absorption system over 1,750,000 Btu/h (512.9 kW)	\$82.75	\$96.65

6. Evaporative Coolers For each evaporative cooler other than the portable type	\$9.50	\$10.65

For each ventilation system which is not a portion of a heating or air-conditioning system authorized by a permit	\$9.50	\$10.65
For the installation of each hood which is served by a mechanical exhaust, including the ducts for such a hood.	\$9.50	\$10.65
8. Incinerators. For the installation or relocation of each domestic type incinerator	\$16.25	\$18.20
For the installation or relocation of each commercial or industrial type incinerator	\$66.50	
9. Miscellaneous. For each appliance or piece of equipment regulated by the Mechanical Code but not classes in other appliance categories, or for which no other fee is listed in the Code	\$9.50	\$10.65
When Appendix B, Chapter 13., is applicable (See Section 103), permit fees for fuel gas piping shall be as follows:		
For each gas pipe system of one to four outlets	\$5.50	\$6.50
For each gas piping system additional outlets over 5, each	\$1.00	\$1.50
When Appendix B, Chapter 14, is applicable (See Section 103), permit fees for process piping shall be as follows:		
For each hazardous process piping system (HPP) on one to four outlets	\$5.00	
For each piping system of five or more outlets, per outlet	\$1.00	
For each non hazardous process piping system (NPP) of one to four outlets	\$2.00	
For each piping system of five or more outlets, per outlet	\$.50	
Other Inspection and Fees		
1. A plan review fee of 25% shall be assessed for other than R-3 and U occupancies		
2. Inspection fees outside business hours, per hour	\$44.25	\$49.50
3. Reinspection fees assess under provisions of Section 116.6, per inspection	\$44.25	\$49.50
4. Inspection for which no fee is specifically indicated, (Minimum charge - one half hour)	\$44.25	\$49.50
5. Additional plan review required by changes, additions, or revisions to plans or to plans for which an initial review has been completed (minimum charge one-half hour)	\$44.25	\$49.50

*Or the total hourly cost to the City, whichever is greatest. The cost shall include supervision, overhead, equipment, hourly wages and fringe benefits of the employees involved.
