

RESOLUTION NO. 480

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DIRECTING
THE AWARD OF THE 74TH AVENUE/MORRISON STORM DRAINAGE PROJECT AND
MORRISON ROAD CONNECTION.**

WHEREAS, The City of University Place has advertised for bid proposals for the 74th Avenue and Morrison Road Storm Drainage Relocation Projects; and,

WHEREAS, the City has received requests from the University Place Police Department and Pierce County Fire District No. 3 for the City to connect portions of Morrison Road to allow for improved circulation and emergency vehicle response times; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of involving the neighborhood in selection of appropriate traffic calming devices in the event of the connection of Morrison Road

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

The City of University Place hereby awards the public works contract for Schedules 1, 2, and 3 for the 74th Avenue/Morrison Storm Drainage Pond Relocation Project to DLB Earthwork Co. in the amount of \$2,051,666.50 subject to the contractor agreeing to a change order deleting Items #37 & #38 and hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary contract documents; and,

The City Engineer is directed to work with the Morrison Road neighborhood and the Police and Fire Departments for selection and installation of appropriate traffic calming devices; and,


The City Council authorizes the City Engineer to take the steps necessary to connect the Morrison Road segments in the area of the 3000 block of Morrison Road.
