

RESOLUTION NO. 693

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON,
APPOINTING A COMMITTEE TO REVIEW AND RECOMMEND THE SITING OF AN
AMERICAN FLAG WITHIN UNIVERSITY PLACE TOWN CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that an American flag is an essential element of any city center and should be displayed in the University Place Town Center in the vicinity of the new University Place Library/Civic Building; and

WHEREAS, the City Council acknowledges that the proper design and location of an installation of the American flag within University Place Town Center is a matter that requires careful study and community input; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide an for an appropriate level of study and community input regarding the design and location of an installation of the American flag within University Place Town Center, the City Council desires to convene a temporary committee comprised of Council Members, as well as City residents to thoroughly review and present a design and location recommendation to the full City Council;




3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
