

RESOLUTION NO. 727

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR THE OFFICIAL TIME, PLACE, AND LOCATION OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of University Place has from time to time revised its regular City Council meeting schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a new schedule for regular City Council meetings by resolution, which shall replace and supersede all prior resolutions, 12, 25, 52, and 645 on the subject.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Regular Meetings. The City Council shall hold its regular meetings on the first and third Monday of each month commencing at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall Meeting Room, 3715 Bridgeport Way West, University Place, Washington.

Section 2. Special Meetings. The City Council may hold special meetings at such times and location as may be determined and noticed pursuant to State law.


Section 3. Council Rules. In order to achieve consistency with the regular meeting schedule, Section 7 "Meetings" of the Council Rules is amended to read as provided in the exhibit attached to, and incorporated in, this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.



EXHIBIT TO RESOLUTION NO. 727

SECTION 7. MEETINGS

- A. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings will occur as provided by resolution of the City Council.
- B. Special Meetings. Special meetings may be scheduled in accordance with State law.
- C. Study Sessions. Study Sessions may be held during Regular or Special meetings for the purpose of considering current issues of the City, coordinating the work of the City Council, and discussing draft ordinances, resolutions, and policy issues in detail.
- D. Emergency Meetings. If at any time there is a need for expedited action by the City Council to meet an emergency situation, the Mayor, or in the absence of the Mayor, the Mayor Pro Tem or any four members of Council, may call an emergency meeting at a place and time as necessary, and the meeting shall be noticed and conducted in accordance with State law.
- E. Adjournment. Regular and Special Council Meetings shall adjourn at 9:00 p.m.; Study Sessions shall adjourn at 9:00 p.m. The adjournment times established hereunder may be extended to a later time certain upon approval of a motion by a majority of the Council. During Regular and Special Meetings, any Councilmember may call for a "Point of Order" at 8:30 p.m. to review agenda priorities. After adjournment of Council meetings, City Hall will remain open for 15 minutes to allow for closing procedures. In the event that Council adjourns to Executive Session, staff will secure the equipment and leave City Hall open until the final adjournment.
