

**RESOLUTION NO. 931**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING  
A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITIES OF UNIVERSITY  
PLACE AND FIRCREST REGARDING REPRESENTATION ON THE BOARD OF  
COMMISSIONERS FOR PIERCE TRANSIT**

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2020 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 929, casting its vote for the seat shared between the cities of University Place and Fircrest on the Pierce Transit Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the cities of University Place and Fircrest both wish to memorialize an agreement wherein they would alternate representation to Pierce Transit; and

WHEREAS, an agreement between the Cities in the form of a Memorandum of Understanding has been reached;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNVIERSITY PLACE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Approval of Memorandum of Understanding. The City of University Place approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the Cities of University Place and Fircrest.

Section 2. Completion of Transaction. The City Manager or designee is authorized to take and execute any additional measures or documents that may be necessary to complete this transaction and to implement the Memorandum of Agreement, which are consistent with the executed Agreement and the terms of this Resolution.

Section 3. Corrections. Upon approval by the City Attorney, the City Manager or designee are authorized to make necessary corrections to the proposed Agreement, including the correction of clerical errors; references to other local, state, or federal laws, codes, rules, or regulations; or numbering and section/subsection numbering, as necessary as may be consistent with the associated Agreement and the terms of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
