

RESOLUTION NO. 962

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING AN APPLICANT AGENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF OBTAINING AND ADMINISTERING CERTAIN STATE AND FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER SECTION 404 OF THE ROBERT T. STAFFORD DISASTER RELIEF AND EMERGENCY ACT OF 1988, P.L. 93-288, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the City of University Place has identified the need for state and federal financial assistance for emergency management hazard mitigation projects and desires to obtain funding under the state of Washington Hazard Mitigation Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Military Department, Emergency Management Division is responsible for this Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and requires jurisdictions applying for funding to designate an agent for the purposes of obtaining and administering funding under this program and authorize the agent to provide any assurances and agreements required for all matters concerning such state disaster mitigation to the Emergency Management Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Director of Engineering and Capital Projects is hereby designated as the Applicant Agent for the state of Washington Hazard Mitigation Grant program Application and Grant and hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the City of University Place, any application, grant agreement, and payment requests to be filed with the Military Department, Emergency Management Division, for the purpose of obtaining and administering certain state and federal financial assistance under Section 404 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act of 1988, P.L. 93-288, as amended.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby designated as the Alternate Application Agent for the above stated purposes.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon signing.
