

RESOLUTION NO. 979

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ENGINEERING TO APPLY FOR AND EXECUTE
THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH A GRANT FOR THE CURRAN
APPLE ORCHARD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of University Place has identified the need for funding from the State's Recreation and Conservation Office for improvements to the Curran Apple Orchard Park; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office requires jurisdictions applying for funding to designate and authorize a representative to apply for, administer and execute necessary documents associated with the Curran Apple Orchard Improvement Project

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Director of Engineering and Capital Projects is hereby authorized to act as an authorized representative/agent on behalf of the City of University Place with respect to the Curran Apple Orchard Improvement project for which the City is seeking grant funding assistance.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby designated as the Alternate Authorized Representative for the above stated purposes.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon signing.
