This is a City of University Place sponsored parade. The goal is to provide a community parade that is safe and enjoyable for both participants and spectators, and we endeavor to maintain that tradition. A complete listing of event participation rules is in this packet. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact City of University Place at 253.566.5656.

To participate in the parade, your entry form must be received prior to May 23, 2025, at 4:00pm and if you are a vehicle entry, a representative must attend a pre-parade informational meeting. Informational meeting attendance is encouraged, but optional for walking groups. Parade informational meetings will be offered on the following days/times:

- Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup> 1pm Virtual/Microsoft Teams Meeting
- Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> 10am Virtual/Microsoft Teams Meeting
- Tuesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> 6:30pm Hybrid/City Hall 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor and Virtual Teams Meeting

Please read through the attached parade instruction sheet, route map and safety plan which have been established for your benefit and the safety of the event and its participants.

# PARADE ORDER Color Guard Vehicle Entries Walking Groups

- All parade entrants must remain in motion while on the parade route, unless stopped by law enforcement or parade officials.
- Motorized Vehicle Entries
  - Distribution of candy or other materials is prohibited. This rule is in place for the safety of all attendees, especially children.
  - Walking beside or between the vehicle/float and giving out candy and toys is prohibited.
  - All motorized vehicles must be operated by licensed and trained drivers, regardless of the vehicle's size or use.
  - All vehicle and float operators are required to include proof of current automobile liability insurance with the parade application.
  - All vehicles must have a passenger.
  - All participants must remain in the vehicle for the duration of the parade.
  - Maintain a distance of 35 feet behind the preceding entry.
- Walking Entries
  - o Candy and materials may be distributed to the crowd.
  - No stunts can be performed (cheer & gymnastics groups).
  - Helmets must be worn (skating/skateboard/bicycle entries).
  - Spectators cannot join your group along the parade route.
  - Please keep 20 feet between the entry in front of you.
- All entrants must clean up after their group (animal waste, garbage in staging, loading areas.

#### PARADE INSTRUCTION SHEET

PARADE DATE: June 7, 2025 PARADE START TIME: 10 a.m.

CHECK-IN: Begins at 9am @ Neighborhood Church - 2802 Bridgeport Way West

**STAGING AREAS:** The main staging area for vehicles and floats will be on the South shoulder of 27th street.

Walking Groups will be staged at the Neighborhood Church parking lot at 2802 Bridgeport Way W. Because of limited access to the parade staging area, and for safety reasons, please drop off participants or equipment needed for your entry via Louise St. W./28th St W.



**CHECK-IN - WALKING GROUPS:** All walking group entries **must** stop at the check-in booth located in the staging area at Neighborhood Church. There you will check in and receive any other instructions. *Important: To reduce congestion, please appoint one member of your group to check in for your entire group.* 

**CHECK-IN - VEHICLE ENTRIES:** Please line up along the South shoulder of 27<sup>th</sup> St. W. Parade staff will come to check you in and verify valid driver's license and insurance.

Please note – For safety of all participants all vehicle entries will go first beginning at 10am and no walkers are allowed in the vehicle portion of the parade – it is estimated that the walking groups will enter the parade at 10:30am.

**RESTROOMS:** Restrooms (sani-cans) are located in the staging area and at the end of the parade.

### **PARADE ROUTE**

Public viewing begins at the intersection of 29th and Bridgeport. The parade continues past the Library Civic Building and ends at 37th Street Court W. Vehicles will turn left onto 37<sup>th</sup> St. Court West and exit the area by turning right onto Drexler Drive.



#### **PARADE RULES**

- 1. Drivers should have 180° forward vision.
- 2. Each vehicle/float should have one passenger in the cab whose duty is to monitor activity on the float so that the driver is not distracted from operating the vehicle.
- 3. Reverse movement along the parade route is prohibited.
- 4. Riding on the top of or outside of vehicles without belts or harnesses is prohibited.
- 5. Children must always be under adult supervision.
- 6. Riders must remain on the float once the parade begins and at all times the float is in motion.
- 7. Maintain a distance of 35 feet behind the preceding entry.
- 8. Exhaust system should extend beyond any and all decorations so that drivers or riders are not exposed to carbon monoxide fumes.
- 9. Compressed gases (such as helium) and generators shall be properly secured and safeguarded (portable gasoline cans are prohibited).
- 10. Generator exhaust must be such that it does not pose a hazard to participants.
- 11. Decorative lighting must be UL approved and rated for outdoor use.
- 12. No candles allowed on floats.
- 13. Marching/Walking entries must keep up with the parade.
- 14. Candy/other items cannot be thrown or distributed from vehicles.
- 15. Walking beside or between the vehicle/float and giving out candy and toys is prohibited.
- 16. Entries with animals must check in with their clean-up crews; otherwise, they will not be allowed to participate.
- 17. Contact parade officials immediately should you encounter any difficulties.
- 18. Motorized vehicles, trucks, and cars no excessive speeds, burn-outs, tricks, two-wheel driving, or dangerous maneuvers. NO STOPPING TO HAND OUT FOOD, CANDY, OR PROMOTIONAL PRODUCTS.
- 19. Fire extinguishers rated 2A-10BC are required on all motorized decorated vehicles. Fire or open flame on any entrant is prohibited; all decorative materials must be fire retardant bales of hay are not fire retardant.
- 20. Smoking is prohibited on any float or parade entry.
- 21. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on any float or vehicle or on the person of any participant.
- 22. Parade participants may not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any time during the parade or staging.
- 23. The City reserves the right to bar from the parade at any time any entrant not conforming to the rules, safety plan or refusing to follow the instructions of the police or parade officials.

## If the above criteria are not followed, your entry in future Duck Parades will be denied.

#### **STAGING AREA**

The main staging area for vehicles and floats will be on the South shoulder of 27th Street W. Walking groups will stage in the Neighborhood Church parking lot at 2802 Bridgeport Way W.

CHECK-IN STATION: Walking entries must stop at the check-in station located at the staging area. There you will check-in and receive any other instructions. Important: To reduce congestion, please appoint one member of your group to check in your entire group.

PLEASE KEEP THE CENTER OF THE STAGING AREA CLEAR AT ALL TIMES TO ALLOW FOR PASSAGE OF OTHER ENTRANTS.

- Because of limited access to the parade staging area, and for safety reasons, if you wish to drop off participants or equipment needed for your entry, you must do so prior to 9 am. Drop off participants and equipment via Louise St. W./28th St W.
- ACCESS TO THE STAGING AREA WILL BE CLOSED FOR SUPPORT VEHICLES.
- 3. Vehicle operators must stay with the vehicle at all times.
- 4. No reverse movement will be allowed within the staging area.

# APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS Due Date: May 23, 2025

- Submit a completed Duck Parade Application.
- Submit a Certificate of Insurance for the group OR Submit signed Hold Harmless/Indemnification Waivers for each participant.
- 3. For Vehicle Entries: Submit a copy of the vehicle insurance card and a valid Driver's License for the driver. All vehicles must have a passenger.

Throwing candy or other items from the vehicles shall be prohibited. For safety reasons and to maintain a steady parade pace, people cannot walk along side or between vehicles in the parade.

4. No animals/pets are allowed without registration and proof of vaccinations.

In consideration of the acceptance of this application, the applicant agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of University Place as well as all officers, employees, and volunteers from any injury, damage or loss arising out of the applicant's participation in the Duck Parade.
